Course Requirements

Entry Requirements for the Ordinary Diploma in Business Administration (NTA Level 6)

Applicants must meet one of the following minimum entry qualifications:

- Holders of a Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with four (4) passes in non-religious subjects. A pass in Mathematics and English is an added advantage.
- Holders of an **NTA Level 4 (Basic Technician Certificate)** in Business Administration, Finance and Banking, or Marketing.
- Holders of an Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with at least one principal pass and one subsidiary pass in principal subjects.
- Holders of a **Basic Technician Certificate** in Business Administration, Marketing, or Public Relations with a **GPA of 2.0 or higher**.

Certificate in Biblical Studies (Under Church)

Program Objectives

The Certificate in Biblical Studies program equips students with a solid foundation in the Word of God and a well-rounded understanding of the core teachings of the Bible. It is designed to foster personal spiritual growth and prepare individuals for local ministry or further theological education.

- 2. Achieve a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5.
- 3. Settle all financial obligations with Kibaha Berea Adventist Institute (KBAI).
- 4. Receive a faculty recommendation for graduation.
